Ancient Tomb Culture Gallery

The Ancient Tomb Culture Gallery focuses on the unique tomb culture that emerged around the Yeongsangang River basin. It is designed to deepen visitors understanding of the ancient tomb culture of the inhabitants of the Yeongsangang River basin, who buried their deceased and prayed for eternal life after death.

The Jar Coffins Room exhibits around eighty large jar coffins that show the development of jar coffins by period, and also screens a media artwork on the theme of "Eternal rest" on the wall. The Ancient Tomb Artifact Room exhibits diverse artifacts excavated from ancient tombs, including ironware, beads, earthenware, and other burial accessories, and also introduces the cultural exchanges that took place with other countries through those burial accessories.

History and Culture Gallery

The History and Culture Gallery introduces the history and culture of the ancient society that emerged around the Yeong -sangang River basin, which flows through the southwestern region of Jeollanam-do, and explains the way of life of the people who lived around the Yeongsangang River basin and near the sea from prehistoric times to the Joseon Dynasty. The Prehistory and Ancient History Room introduces the local culture from the Old Stone Age to the Bronze Age, the entrance into ancient society, and the development of ancient society. The Medieval and Early Modern History Room introduces social and cultural aspects of the Unified Silla period and the Goryeo Dynasty, which developed by exploiting the waterways of the Southwest Sea area of Korea. It also provides information about the ideas and rituals, Buddhist culture, and living culture of the Goryeo and Joseon periods.
